AtyKids is a practical, non-medical platform designed for the adults who support neurodivergent children, children with disabilities, or children with additional support needs.

Parents, teachers, aides, educators, and professionals already have access to plenty of information. The difficulty often appears at the moment of taking action:

AtyKids starts from the situation the adult describes and helps them identify a concrete next step, within a clearly defined framework.

AtyKids is now entering a new phase: broadening distribution and exploring collaborations with companies, organizations, institutions, and partners.

The 6 Assistants, the Experts, ATLAS and the Studio make up AtyKids Premium; the Resources remain free. And next time, the adult doesn't start from scratch: what they choose to keep stays available to pick up where they left off, and can be deleted at any time.

TRANSLATION IS NOT ENOUGH. THE TERRITORY CHANGES THE ANSWER.

AtyKids does not certify the quality, availability, or specialization of any professional or organization.

BEING LISTED IN ATLAS DOES NOT MEAN BEING RECOMMENDED BY ATYKIDS.

An official source documents a piece of information. It never means that the institution recommends, endorses, or validates AtyKids.

TRUST BEGINS WITH EXPLICIT LIMITS.

1 — NON-MEDICAL

AtyKids is not a medical device.

The platform does not provide:

- diagnosis
- screening
- risk scoring
- clinical testing
- psychometric assessment
- medical opinion
- prescription
- care plan

And it never replaces a qualified professional.

2 — ADULT FIRST

AtyKids is designed for the adult who provides support.

These controls apply to classification and adherence to the framework.

4 — SOURCES & TRACEABILITY

DOCUMENTED FACT

Information backed by an identifiable source, a territory, and, where applicable, a verification date.

EXPLANATION

Context that makes the information understandable.

SUGGESTION

A practical idea to try and adapt; it is neither an obligation nor an institutional fact.

Documented public content — notably the Glossary, the Guides, and ATLAS — shows its references when the topic requires it.

Private conversational responses are an aid to the adult; they are never presented as a documentary source or as medical advice.

A SOURCE DOCUMENTS A PIECE OF INFORMATION. IT DOES NOT VALIDATE ATYKIDS.

None of the institutional sources cited by AtyKids has, by the mere fact of being cited, endorsed or evaluated the platform.

MINIMIZE DATA. GIVE USERS CONTROL. STATE CLEARLY WHAT IS CLAIMED.

MINIMIZATION

AtyKids applies a minimization principle: only the data necessary for each use should be collected.

PAYMENTS

Payments are processed by Stripe.

Card data does not pass through AtyKids' servers.

THE CHILD'S IDENTITY IS NOT REQUIRED

In free-text fields, AtyKids asks users not to unnecessarily submit:

- a child's full name
- an address or contact details
- health information that is not needed
- information allowing direct identification

AtyKids does not claim any institutional validation, certification, or scientific evaluation that has not been formally obtained.

AtyKids is available directly to users today: some resources are open without an account, the everyday tools open with a free account, and the 6 Assistants, the Experts, ATLAS and the Studio make up the Premium environment.

In parallel, AtyKids is exploring distribution and collaboration models with organizations able to facilitate or fund that access. No standardized organizational offer is published today: these models are built from real needs.

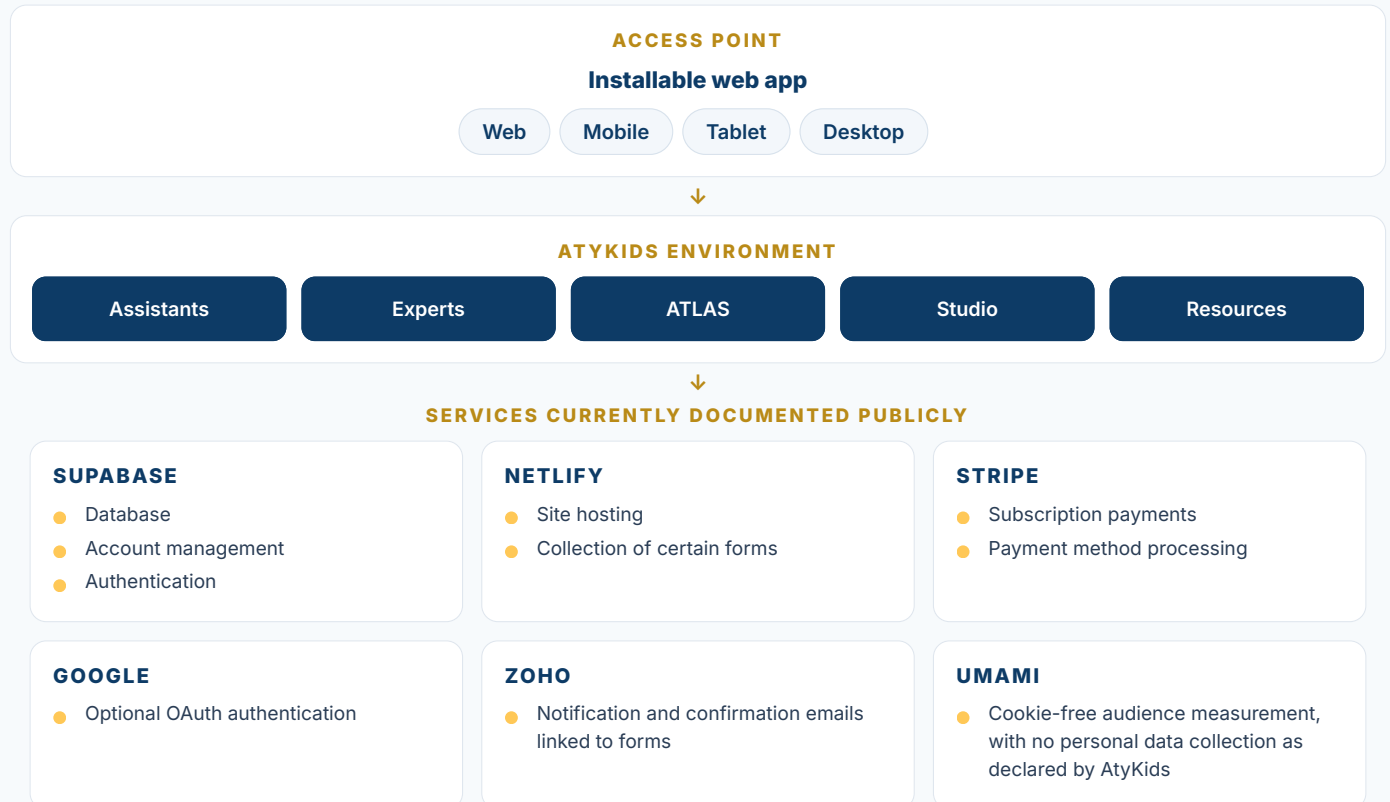

CONVERSATIONAL PROCESSING

The operation of the Assistants means that a conversational processing provider processes the content necessary for the exchange on behalf of AtyKids.

The contractual and technical details of this processing must be verified and documented through appropriate due diligence before any enterprise commitment.

DATA PRINCIPLES

- Minimization
- The child's identity is not required for operation
- Data is neither sold nor rented
- Data export
- Account deletion
- Payments processed by Stripe, with card data never passing through AtyKids' servers
